Surf Boat Report

We kicked off the season with the NSW Premiership 1st round. We only took two crews away for this one. The U23 crew finished the day in third place after rowing strongly all day in what could only be described as atrocious conditions. The "A" crew, well it wasn't their day after copping the full brunt of the rough conditions on more than one occasion.

The second round of the Peters series saw us travel to Ocean Beach on the Central Coast. We took away 7 crews ranging from U23's to masters. By far the largest contingent from the Hunter Valley and and possibly the central Coast also. The results listed below are derived from 91 crews entered in this series. This equates to over 450 surf boat rowers just from the Hunter and Central Coast regions.
